³⁵₁₇ Officer Dawson presented the monthly crime report. Typical handouts were not available at this meeting.

³⁵₁₇ Thieves worked their way down Linwood breaking into automobiles.

³⁵₁₇ Police Chief Blackwell is organizing a Town Meeting on Tuesday, April 29, 2014 at J. P. Parker Elementary School.

³⁵₁₇ A medical waste disposal day is scheduled for Saturday, April 26, 2014. Drop off sites are at CVS in Oakley and Walgreens in Mt. Washington. Residents can drop off unused / unwanted medications they might have and want to dispose of. This prevents medications from being flushed into the city waste water system which ends up in the area waterways and potentially into the city water system. When medications are dropped off, no questions will be asked of the resident.

³⁵₁₇ A resident was asked about the new bike lanes: if someone is parked on the street adjacent to the bike lane, generally the automobile is responsible for looking for the bicyclists before opening the car door.

- Golf Scramble reminder. This is a community event and major fundraiser for the community.
- Landscape on the square: flower planting and neighborhood clean up scheduled for this Friday.
- Reminder about the Ault Park July 4th event.
- A resident asked about the Delta Avenue re-paving. Safety concerns were expressed by the resident. The issue of concern is turning off Glengyle Ave onto Delta Ave. When turning right onto Delta with only one lane to turn onto the resident feels the new lane configuration is not as safe as before. The resident is also concerned that the bike lane is not continuous. Last, it is not safe going through the square.
