³⁵₁₇ Laure Quinlivan, Cincinnati City Council member spoke to the MLCC

- Student Housing: new smoke detector requirements and optional inspection by the fire department.
- Flower Pot program is being re-funded after being cut a few weeks ago. The program is called “Business District Improvement Program”. This program will start in the spring and continue year round.
- The city is also re-funding the annual \$5,000 funds given to each community in the city.
- Discussed Lunken Airport and the new airline. Community members expressed concern that more airlines and expansion would be coming in the future. Councilwoman Quinlivan said she will pay attention to the issue.
- Discussed the Eastern Corridor project. Councilwoman Quinlivan said that many of the more controversial aspects of the projects are losing support. There will be a meeting between the affected communities and ODOT next week.
